Mark your calendars! The 2018 State MYHEC event will be held on **August 18 & 19, 2018**. The MYHEC board would like to reassure participants that you will have a wonderful time shooting, making new friends, testing your skills and developing new skills over this weekend packed with fun!

Fundraising Opportunities:

As time goes on and operating costs continue to rise, the MYHEC board is working hard to keep your participation cost at a minimum; however, we need your help to be able to do this. As of today, May 18th, we need to raise \$11,000 to make the 2018 state event happen. You will have the choice of picking your order up at the state event – August 18 & 19th – for no additional fee or having your order shipped directly to your home by paying an additional shipping fee at the time you order.

MYHEC Hats / Visors

Hats and visors with the MYHEC logo will be available at the information booth during the State MYHEC event.

Jerky Sticks

County Meats jerky sticks will be sold during the event for \$1 at all eight events.

Coach Division

Coaches with full teams of five (5) registered team members may participate in the Coach Division. Registration Fee is \$75.00 - deadline to register is August 1st – may participate for certificate or for fun. Completed details for this division can be obtained at MYHEC.org.

Location & Date for State Event:

Capital Area Sportsmen League (CASL), 7534 Old River Trail, Lansing, MI, will host the 2018 MYHEC event on **August 18 & 19, 2018**.

Registration Fee: \$35 - registrations must be received postmarked no later than August 1st to be accepted.

Hunter Safety Certificates:

ALL PARTICIPANTS must send a copy of their Hunter Safety Certificate along with their registration form; it must be on file before participating in any of the MYHEC events. These records are not kept on file from year to year.

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On-Line Registration:

All MYHEC participant registrations will be made on-line for the 2018 state event.

To assure you an opportunity to participate in the 2018 MYHEC event you must:

- Register online at MYHEC.org
 - Go to MYHEC.org, Events Tab, select 2018 State Event / Participant Registration
 - Fill out each category and click submit, Note: a registration form is available on the website for coaches to use to gather the necessary information needed to enter in the online registration
 - Participant emails are to be entered when registering instead of the coach's email
 - You will receive an email confirming your on-line registration along with an Event Release Form
- Mail the following to registrar Heather Hicks (address in side panel of this letter):
 - Event Release Form, which **must be signed in the two (2)** areas by a parent or guardian
 - Copy of your Hunter Safety Certificate
 - Registration Fee, which is non-refundable.
 - Make checks or money orders payable to 'MYHEC'.

Registration Confirmation Letter: You will receive your registration confirmations by email. 1) The first email will confirm you have completed the on-line portion of registration. 2) The second email will confirm we have received your registrar, payment, hunter safety card and signed liability form. 3) The third and final email will be sent after August 10th which will include the final details for the 2018 event. 2018 Rule Changes: Current Rules & Regulations governing the 2018 MYHEC event are posted on our website at www.MYHEC.org. Only one change has been made to the archery rules and regulations for the 2018 event; no sky drawing will be allowed. The state MYHEC Rules & Regulations coincide very closely with those for the YHEC International event. MYHEC's fifth U.P. Regional event will be held in Chippewa County is located in Eastern Upper Peninsula on Saturday, June 23, 2018. This is a one day event for youth ages 18 years old and younger that have a hunter safety certificate on file along with their registration form. Registration fee is \$20 and must be postmarked on or before midnight of June 10th.

Qualified volunteers are needed for all eight events and support areas:

Event	Skills Needed to Assist
Archery	Must be comfortable working with archery equipment and with youth. Must be capable of walking long distances.
Muzzleloading	Must have a working knowledge of muzzleloaders and be comfortable working with muzzleloaders and with youth.
Rifle	Must be comfortable working with rifles w/ various action types and working with youth
Shotgun	Must be comfortable working with shotguns, scoring and working with youth.
Orienteering	No particular skills are needed to assist with this event. You will be taught what you will need to know on the morning of the event. It is not difficult.
Responsibility Exam	No particular skill is needed to assist with this event.
Safety Trail	We are looking specifically for Hunter Education Instructors and DNR officers to help with this event.
Wildlife ID	No particular skill is needed to assist with this event.
Event Registrar	Must be capable of keeping paper work organized; oversee youth/coaches who are waiting, assist event director with orientation and other tasks as needed. Need up to seven (one per event).
Office Help	Friday – need at least 3 office assistants to help with set-up. Saturday/Sunday – need at least 3 office assistants to help with volunteer sign in, volunteer meal tickets/menus, selling MYHEC items, etc.
Volunteer Snack/Water	Saturday/Sunday mornings: 1-2 assistants to help coordinator carry out their tasks
Photographer(s)	Looking for someone capable of preparing 2017 event pictures to show on screen at closing ceremony. Need several photographers willing to submit their pictures for this project.
